Registering for the new season.....

Registering for the 2010/2011 season has never been easier. You can register online through lifesavingonline.com.au at either of the registration dates set down by Branch; at the AGM; or any Sunday morning at the beach. This year the Branch dates for Registrations have been set for September 12th and September 19th.

Membership Subscriptions

Membership fees are consistent across all sections of the Club. A family is defined as up to two parents plus their children up to age of 18.

Changes to the clubs registration fees come into effect on October 1st. Those who register prior to that date will see few changes to their registration costs. Those registering on or after October 1st will pay the new fees. These fees will continue through to the next season. 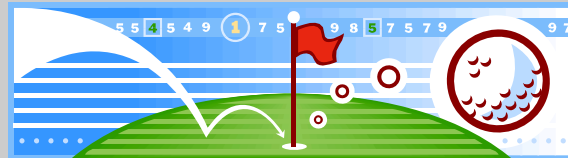

For those members wishing to use the gym, there is a one-off cost of \$50 for a key which is refundable on return of the key. Associate members are charged an additional \$125 per annum for gym membership. This means the total cost in the first year for a new Associate with gym is \$230, and for subsequent years it's \$180 per year. Post October 31st, the one-off cost of \$50 for a key remains the same. Associate members are charged an additional \$150 per annum for gym membership. This means the total cost in the first year for a new Associate with gym is \$270, and for subsequent years it's \$220 per year (stc).

Bronze medallion course - Standard membership fee plus cost of training materials, usually totaling around \$100.

From October 1st, if joining as a Junior Activities member, this fee includes a parent registration as Junior Activities Associate. Patrolling members should be calculated prior to subsequent members (including children) when determining the family membership subscription due. If the parent is a patrolling member, please use the "1st family member" rate in calculating your membership fees.

Course Purpose:

The aim of this course is to provide participants with the skills and knowledge to manage multifaceted emergency situations in an advanced manner.

Prerequisites:

- Minimum of 17 years of age on the date of assessment
- Hold a current Senior First Aid Certificate (CPR component must have been updated in the past 12 months)
- Hold a current SLSA Advanced Resuscitation Certificate
- Hold a current Defibrillation Certificate

Course Content:

- Priority Management (triage of patients)
- Identifying Strategies
- Prioritising, Identifying and Selecting Strategies
- Problem Solving, Planning, Choosing Strategies
- Scenarios (Casualty Simulation)

Process:

Those Surf life Savers who are interested in attending the course need to advise their Club's Chief Training Officer or Club Administration. **Clubs should book candidates in for this course via email to sandy@surflifesaving.net.au before the COB on 26th July 2010.** The course is limited to approx. 20 candidates.

These important roles are currently vacant for both the Junior and Senior club. The main responsibility of the role is to enter names into the SLS site for carnivals - yes, training will be provided. Please consider taking one of these roles, either individually or as part of a team. Without people to fill these roles, no-one within the club can compete. Pool Closure

To complete repairs to the South Curly ocean pool, Warringah Council is intending to close the pool for a 3 month period from either August or September. We hope this will not impact the beginning of the season too much.

Child Protection

Recent changes to the way SLS manages Prohibited Employment Declarations for Volunteers come into effect next season. This means if you have signed a PED during the 09/10 season, there is no need to sign another form unless it has been misplaced, your circumstances have changed, or you have had an absence from SLS for more than 12 months. The below excerpt from Circular 3170 outlines the new requirements, and how it can be accessed online.

VOLUNTEER / STUDENT DECLARATION FORM

The Commission for Children and Young People Act 1998, require Surf Life Saving New South Wales (SLSNSW) to ask all new members and volunteers and members renewing their membership after a leave of absence of at least one season, to sign the Volunteer / Student Declaration. All new members, and volunteers, over the age of 18 and those members under the age of 18 who work with children (eg: 16yr olds who help train the U/8 Nippers, provide water safety for Nippers, etc) **MUST** sign the Volunteer / Student Declaration **ONCE**

ONLY. Members under 18 years can have a parent or guardian co-sign.

SLSNSW require clubs to keep the signed volunteer/student declaration form in a secure location for as long as that member is a part of the club. ** Please note that changes have been made to this process, and members need only sign the form once. This has been changed from previous years to reduce the burden on clubs. Clubs must ensure that every member has this box ticked on SurfGuard. It is an offence for prohibited persons to sign this declaration or to apply for or attempt to obtain, undertake or remain in child-related employment in any capacity, whether paid, volunteering or self-employed. The maximum penalty for falsely declaring that you are not a person prohibited from child related employment is 12 months imprisonment, 100 penalty units (\$11,000) or both.

CHANGES TO THE FORM

- The form is now able to be completed online. The form must be fully completed, printed and signed and then

brought to the club to verify the new members' identity. Please go to <https://check.kids.nsw.gov.au/volunteer-declaration.php>

- Appropriate identifying documentation (Drivers License, Passport etc) will need to be supplied to, and sighted by a club official when a member initially completes the declaration
- Club declaration forms can now be randomly audited by the Commission for Children and Young People, and members consent to this by ticking the box on page two of the declaration.

Recording Completion of Form on SurfGuard The completion of the Volunteer/Student Declaration must be recorded in SurfGuard. This involves ticking the Member Protection Form Completed Box and entering the date for the current year.

If applicants do not complete a Volunteer / Student Declaration their membership application/renewal cannot be accepted.

Nippers Updates

NIPPERS OFFICIALS

- WE NEED MORE!

It is a Surf Lifesaving Australia requirement that clubs provide officials at all carnivals. Without officials from our club, we are not allowed to compete at carnivals. For each 10 competitors entered we need to provide 1 official. We were getting 80-100 children participating in carnivals last season but we don't have anywhere near 10 officials to supply. We have been warned and will need to reduce our competitor numbers if we don't supply the

required number of "carnival officials". The course is one day (weekend), not onerous at all and no experience necessary!

Our hope is to be able to have each official only having to attend 2 of the 4 local carnivals to spread the load. At the carnivals, you can choose your preferred area to work in ie. beach or water and nominate your child's age group also so you don't miss their races at all.

Please consider doing the Carnival Officials course for the club, it

would be much appreciated. There are courses scheduled for next season so far:
